### SPANISH 1115. ELEMENTARY SPANISH I

Study of advanced grammar and stylistics, with emphasis on composition skills, designed to bring students to a high level of proficiency in writing.

**SPANISH 3463            ADVANCED DICTION AND PHONETICS** *Prerequisite: 20 credit hours of Spanish or equivalent proficiency.*

Required course for teacher certification/licensure. Spanish speech sounds and intonation patterns, with practice to improve the student's pronunciation.

**SPANISH 4123            HISPANIC POETRY** *Prerequisite: Spanish 3003 or 3013*

Detailed study of representative poetry from Spain and/or Latin America.

**SPANISH 4263            MASTERPIECES OF HISPANIC LITERATURE II** *Prerequisite: One 3000 level Spanish course or equivalent proficiency.*

Reading and analysis of classics selected from the Hispanic literatures. A continuation of 4253.
